ITINERARY

Monday, June 13, 2022

Park your car at Wes & Karen's farm site and join us as we head to this western, North Dakota town filled with history that comes alive as we learn about Medora and its rugged past. We travel through some of the best farmland in the country in the Red River Valley. We stop at Carol Widman's Candy Shop home of the famous chocolate covered potato chips (and so much more!) Karen and Wes will provide your noon meal while on board the motorcoach today. Continue our journey west into the Mountain Time Zone and visit the Painted Canyon Overlook enjoying some of God's beautiful creations. This evening enjoy some relaxation time at the hotel as Wes & Karen serve you your evening meal. Overnight Medora, ND (Dinner & Supper included today).



Tuesday, June 14, 2022

At the Medora's Life Skills Center we enjoy an included breakfast buffet. Following breakfast we tour the Chateau de Mores. This 26-room, two-story frame building was built in 1883 as the summer residence of the Marquis's family. The Chateau is now a historic house museum and contains many of the original furnishings and personal effects of the de Mores family. Located southwest of Medora, this site memorializes the life and activities in North Dakota of Antoine de Vallombrosa, the Marquis de Mores, who arrived in 1883. Among his enterprises were a beef packing plant, a stagecoach line, a freighting company, refrigerated railway cars, cattle and sheep raising, land ownership, and a new town which he called Medora, in honor of his wife.

After dinner we tour the Theodore Roosevelt National Park South Unit. Keep an eye out for elk, bison, wild horses, prairie dogs and more as we tour this 7000 acre national park. Teddy Roosevelt spent a lot of time in Medora and one of the nations best impersonators of him is Joe Wiegand. Joe brings America's legendary 26th President to life in this vivid and rousing presentation which we attend later this afternoon.



Now it's time for the Pitchfork Fondue. As seen on the Food Network, the chefs load up pitchforks with 12 oz steaks and fondue them western style! Paired with all your favorite fixin's and an unbelievable view of the Badlands, this is a perfect supper any night, and even better when paired with the Medora



Musical just a few steps away. Your steak comes with fresh fruit, salad, coleslaw, vegetables, baked beans, garlic toast, baked potatoes, brownies, cinnamon-sugar donuts, lemonade and coffee.

The Medora Musical is the rootin'-tootiest, boot-scootiest show in all the Midwest. There's no other show quite like it. It's an ode to patriotism, Theodore Roosevelt, and the Great American West! Performed live and outside, the show is dedicated to President Theodore Roosevelt's time in the Badlands and to the Spirit of the Old West. That's not all though, we'll also enjoy live singing and dancing by the Burning Hills Singers, made up of world-class performers from around the nation; and high-energy country and western music by the live Coal Diggers Band. Overnight Medora, ND (Breakfast, Dinner and Supper included today).



Wednesday, June 15, 2022

Start the morning off with another hearty breakfast buffet before we begin our journey home. This morning we drive the Enchanted Highway. A metal sculptor and retired Regent schoolteacher, Gary Greff's plan was to create

ten huge sculptures, paired with pullouts, every few miles along Regency-Gladstone Road -- which he christened The Enchanted Highway. The Enchanted Highway, a 32 mile stretch of highway, features some of the world's largest scrap metal sculptures. The sculpture "Geese in Flight", is currently listed in the Guinness World Book of Records as the Largest Scrap Metal Sculpture in the entire world! We arrive home this evening. (Breakfast and Dinner included today).
