Join us as we venture west to view some of the most beautiful landscapes we have in North America. Wes & Karen

Saturday, July 6, 2024

Board the motorcoach at Wes and Karen's early this morning and get to know our fellow travelers as we make our way to Minot, ND. We start to get feel for what Lewis and Clark saw as they explored the Plains of the Dakotas and made their way west. Overnight, Minot, ND

Sunday, July 7, 2024

Today we board Amtrak's Empire Builder train in Minot and ride the rails to Shelby, Montana. James J. Hill and his Great Northern Railway played a major role in the development of the northwest region of the United States. Amtrak took over the rail service in the early 70's and named this particular train the "Empire Builder" after the nickname that James J. Hill acquired during the heyday of the railroad industry. Enjoy an included pizza party tonight at the hotel. Overnight tonight Shelby, MT (B,S)

Monday, July 8, 2024

Have your passport ready today as we cross the border into Canada. It is a short morning's drive to Calgary where we see some of the best cowboys and cowgirls compete in Calgary Stampede. This traditional outdoor western show has been going on for over 100 years. This afternoon we attend the Calgary Stampede Rodeo followed by the nightly chuckwagon races held every evening of the stampede. Overnight, Calgary, AB (B)

Tuesday, July 9, 2024

We make our way north into the heart of the Canadian Rockies. Enjoy the wonderful view as we travel to the town of Banff where you can take an optional Gondola ride, or browse the streets of Banff and enjoy the sights of this wonderful city nestled in the mountains. A step on guide joins us for a tour of the city. Overnight Lake Louise, AB (B,S)

Wednesday, July 10, 2024

We journey north on the Icefields Parkway. The Columbia Icefield is located on the boundary of Banff and Jasper National Parks. One of the largest accumulations of ice and snow south of the Arctic Circle, it covers an area of nearly 90 square miles, sometimes reaching a depth of 1000 feet. The continuous accumulation of snow feeds eight major glaciers including the Athabasca, Dome, and Stutfield Glaciers, all visible from the Icefields Parkway. The Columbia Icefield's melted water feeds streams and rivers that pour into the Arctic, Atlantic, and Pacific

oceans. Midway through our journey you will ride in one of the specially designed Ice Explorers out on to the Athabasca Glacier where we will actually get to step out of the vehicle and spend some time on this ancient ice! Following a bit more sightseeing, we make our way back to Lake Louise where we spend the night. Overnight Lake Louise, AB (B)

Thursday, July 11, 2024

This morning we enjoy the view of Lake Louise and the Victoria Glacier. You can rent a canoe or take a hike around this wonderful gem. Later on this morning we travel through the Rockies to our overnight stay of Kalispell, MT. Overnight Kalispell, MT (B,L)

Friday, July 12, 2024

Are you ready to ride the "Red Jammer?" These vintage vehicles have been refurbished and are ready to take us on the famous "Going To The Sun Road." Enjoy the breathtaking views as we cross over Logan's Pass and make our way to St. Mary's where our motorcoach will pick us up. Overnight Havre, MT (B)

Saturday, July 13, 2024

Enjoy a relaxing ride across the plains of Montana as we make our way to one of Teddy Roosevelt's favorite places...Medora, ND. Join Joe Wiegand, the world's best Theodore Roosevelt reprisor, as he tells stories of his time living and ranching in the Badlands. Learn about TR's first visit to Medora on a bison hunt, his ranching days, his fight with the Mingusville Bully and his capture of the notorious "Boat Thieves!" This evening we will enjoy a pitchfork fondue steak supper with all the fixins followed by the wonderful Medora Musical. Overnight Medora, ND (B,S)

Sunday, July 14, 2024

Wow! We hope you have enjoyed some of North America's best scenery. Before we leave Medora we visit Theodore Roosevelt National Park and enjoy the Badlands of North Dakota. It is our hope you have made new friends along the way. You can spend today remembering all the sights we visited as we make our way back home arriving home early evening. (B)
