Itinerary

Sunday, March 8, 2026

Board our "stagecoach" and join us on this tour to Texas! A few of our friends approached us that they wanted to go to rodeos in Texas, and were wondering if we could put a trip together. Seeing how we are "retired" we thought that going to Texas in the winter time would be awesome, so here is the tour that we have put together. Today will be spent getting to know our travel partners. We will board the bus early this morning (like about 6:30 AM) at Wes & Karen's place south of Appleton. We overnight tonight at the Drury Inn and Suites in Overland Park, KS. Drury Inn's provide a "kickback" supper as part of our hotel stay. This kickback includes a couple of free drinks, plus menu items that vary each night. Monday, March 9, 2026

Included breakfast at the hotel, followed by another somewhat early departure. (Kind of like 6:30 AM again) We need to get on the road to see the Oklahoma City National Memorial. The Memorial Museum is an interactive learning experience that occupies the west end of the former Journal Record Building. Built in 1923, this building withstood the bombing. The state-of-the-art Memorial Museum takes visitors on self-guided tours through the story of those who were killed, those who survived and those changed forever by the April 19, 1995, bombing of the Alfred P. Murrah Federal Building. We continue our journey to the Drury Inn and Suites in Richardson, Texas where we spend the night and enjoy the Drury Evening Kickback. Overnight Richardson, Texas.

Tuesday, March 10, 2026

Included breakfast at the hotel. Hey you didn't pay to sleep...so we are going to get rolling early yet again today. This afternoon we will visit the Johnson Space Center in Houston. "Houston, the Eagle has landed." Do you remember that saying when Neil Armstrong radioed back to Mission Control when they landed safely on the moon? This evening we will be attending the Houston Livestock Show and Rodeo. Overnight at the Drury Inn Houston by the Galleria. Overnight Houston.

Wednesday, March 11, 2026

Finally...you catch a break and get to sleep in a bit today! Enjoy an included breakfast at the hotel. We make our way west to San Antonio where we will be spending the next two nights. This afternoon we visit the Alamo. Established in 1718 as Mission San Antonio de Valero, the former mission now known as the Alamo has been a crossroads of history. Having existed under five flags of independent nations and served as a garrison for five different armies, the Alamo has a rich history and a heritage to inspire. Following our visit there, we check into our Drury Inn and Suites on the Riverwalk in downtown San Antonio. The doors of the Drury Inn & Suites River Walk open to the Paseo del Rio, a shopping, dining and entertainment district in downtown San Antonio. This building sits on a bend of the San Antonio River, known today as the San Antonio River Walk. Tonight you can enjoy the complimentary Drury Kickback or you may go out to eat at one of the many restaurants along the riverwalk. Be sure to take a scenic boat ride on the river. At night is a wonderful time to enjoy the many lights while traveling on the river taxi's. Overnight San Antonio Drury Inn on the Riverwalk.

Thursday, March 12, 2026

Enjoy an included breakfast at the hotel. We will then learn about the San Antonio Missions Historic Park. Established over 300 years ago, Mission San Jose survives as an artifact of the Spanish Colonial period. Four Spanish colonial missions and their associated features make up San Antonio Missions National Historical Park today. Beginning in 1718, five mission communities formed along the San Antonio River. These missions were at the northern frontier of New Spain, a territory of the Spanish Empire. These Spanish colonial missions transformed local ways of life by introducing a new religion, farming, and settled communities. This afternoon will be free for you to explore the San Antonio Riverwalk area and all of the shops and eateries it has to offer. Overnight Drury Inn San Antonio Riverwalk. **Meals included: Breakfast and Drury Kick Back supper**

Friday, March 13, 2026

After enjoying an included breakfast at the hotel, we travel a short way to Austin where we learn about Lyndon B. Johnson at his presidential library. LBJ was a force of personality, a master of power and the political process, and had a boundless appetite for social reform. Intent on fulfilling the promise of America, he signed an unparalleled 200+ landmark laws during his five years in office. This afternoon we spend at the Austin Rodeo and Fairgrounds. This evening we attend the Austin Rodeo and concert. Overnight at the Austin Drury Inn and Suites in Austin, TX. Overnight in Austin, TX.

Saturday, March 14, 2026

After an included breakfast at our hotel, we venture north to Waco, Texas where Chip and Joanna from the show "Fixer Upper" have made a name for themselves. We will visit the Magnolia Market where Chip and Joanna are passionate about helping people make space for meaningful moments in life and at home. Worth Cattle Drive and Rodeo. Enjoy the many sights this afternoon at the Stockyards area, and this evening we attend our final Ft. Worth Rodeo. Overnight at a hotel in the Stockyards. Overnight Ft. Worth.

Enjoy an included breakfast at our hotel. Today we venture back into the heart of the country as we make our way north to Independence, MO. Plenty of time to take a nap, and talk about the rodeos we have seen, the sights we have visited and the people we have met. Overnight Drury Inn and Suites, Independence, MO.

Included breakfast at the hotel. If time allows we will visit Subtropolis. This is a series of underground storage areas where there is actually an international trade zone made underground in caves. We then continue north as we make our way back home to Wes & Karen's house early this evening. Notes from Wes & Karen:

In October, Kevin & Twyla Hanson, Chuck and Jean Stranberg and Chuck and JoDee Erickson took Karen and Wes out for a retirement supper. (These are all ag teacher friends. During that time together we discussed the possibility of putting together a tour to Texas in March that would focus mostly on the rodeos going on in Texas at that time. This tour is a result of that discussion.

We have incorporated the Houston Livestock show and rodeo, the rodeo at Austin, TX and the rodeo at the Ft. Worth Stockyards to get our fix of rodeos. We have incorporated a two-night stay at the Drury Inn Riverwalk in San Antonio.

Hurdles we face...

- The rodeos do not put a "hold" on tickets. We have to go into the system (like AXS or Ticketmaster) and buy them when they go on sale. (with no refunds) The Houston and Austin Rodeo is not available until after the first of the year. Ft. Worth we can go and buy right away. These could sell out fast depending on who the concert performer is after the rodeos in Houston and Austin. We do not know that information as of the publishing of this brochure.
- Ft. Worth Hotel has a cancellation policy that is not friendly from a tour operators' perspective. The sooner we know the room numbers the better.
- We have based this tour on 15 paying people. At this number Wes & Karen are breaking even. (kind of like farming....going through the motions, but no profit) We need people to make a commitment soon and hopefully not back out, because others are counting on those to sign up to make this tour happen.
- We recommend that you purchase trip insurance to protect you should you have to cancel. There will be no refunds after January 5, as that is when we have to reduce room counts. Here are a few links to trip insurance companies:
